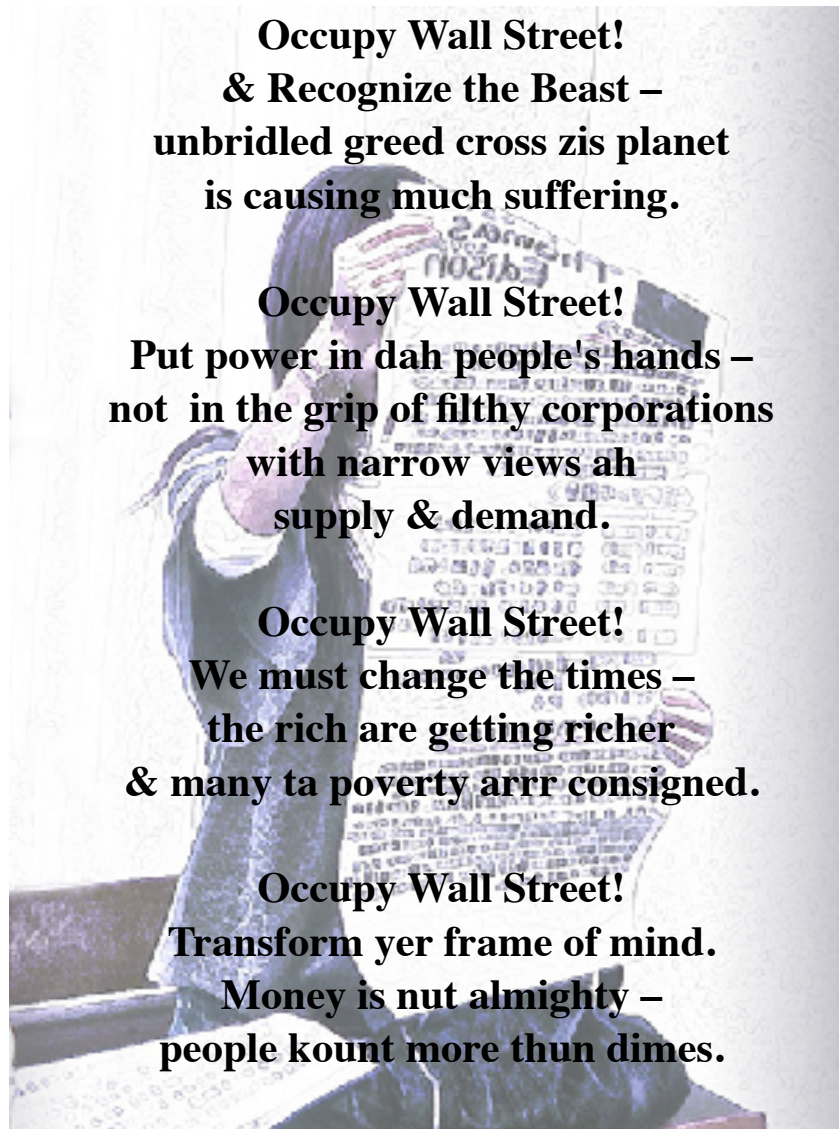


OCCUPY WALL STREET
