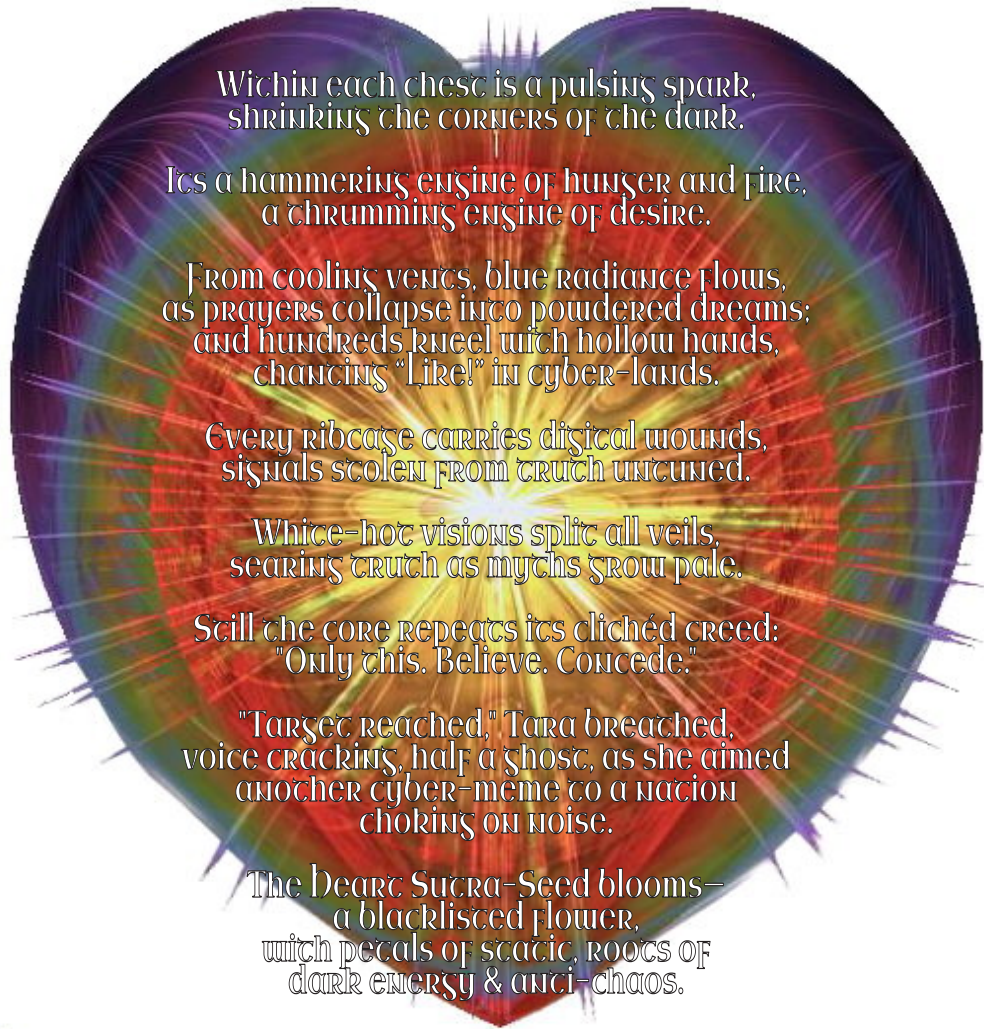


HEART SEEDS:
